
Circular no. 23 (15.10.2018)

Dear Parent

Safety and security of students has always been our prime concern. During our deliberations, we have decided to further enhance our safety measures for children travelling in our school buses as well as for those who are not availing the transport facility. You are requested to comply with the rules:

- a) The parents must personally pick up child from the allotted bus stop in case child is using school bus or from the school in case child is a walker.
- b) It is mandatory for parents to carry and produce Parent's copy of the I Card whenever they come to school / bus stop for picking up their ward or visit school even for any other purpose/issue.
- c) In case of an emergency, when parents are unavailable, the immediate siblings, grandparents must carry I-card issued by the school, failing which the child will be brought back to the school.
- d) Use of motorbikes as a means of regular transport by students, is strictly prohibited. Any default in this regard will be construed as misconduct, entailing the child for withdrawal / expulsion from the school.
- e) As per the directives of Haryana Government, the private vans, rikshapullers, autorikshaws are not allowed to ferry school children.
- f) **In case of use of private vans etc, parents must ensure the following:**
 - i. the drivers do not carry more children than the seating capacity of the vehicle.
 - ii. the private van and autorickshaws drivers must have a valid license issued by licensing authorities.
 - iii. the driver's character and antecedents are verified by the police.
 - iv. there is a lady attendant/mother volunteer present in the van.
 - v. First Aid Kit is present in the vehicle.
 - vi. if the vans etc are impounded by the traffic police, parents need to make arrangements for dropping/picking up the students from school.
 - vii. at the back of the van, contact numbers of the van owner, police, ambulance etc must be mentioned .
 - viii. the private vehicles are not under the control and management of the school. Hence, parents need to be extra careful and vigilant while hiring Private vans, rikshaws or autorikshaws.
- g) The daily dispersal is monitored by our security staff and school personnel. We expect our school community to respect our school ethos and set a good example of their own behaviour while dealing with our work force.
